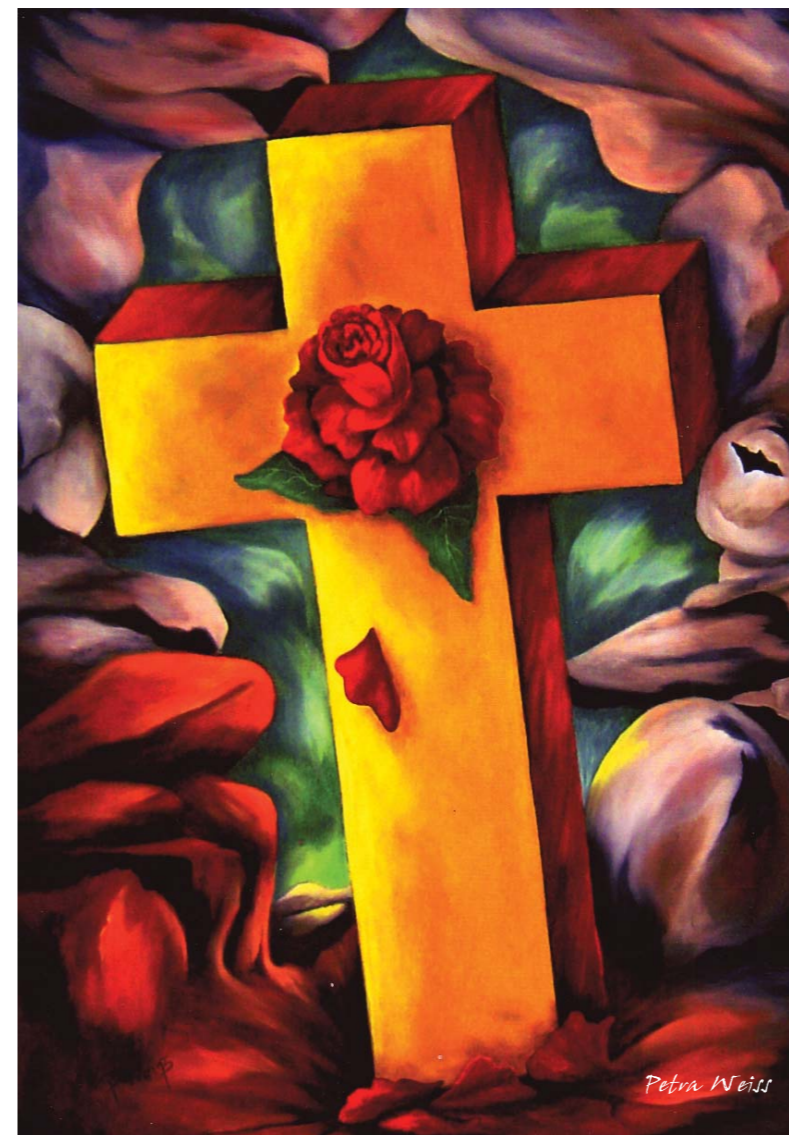
This new 'Gallery' page provides a place to display pictures by people who may not have the means or the opportunity to be extensively featured in our magazine.

GEMMA LOUISE HAWORTH

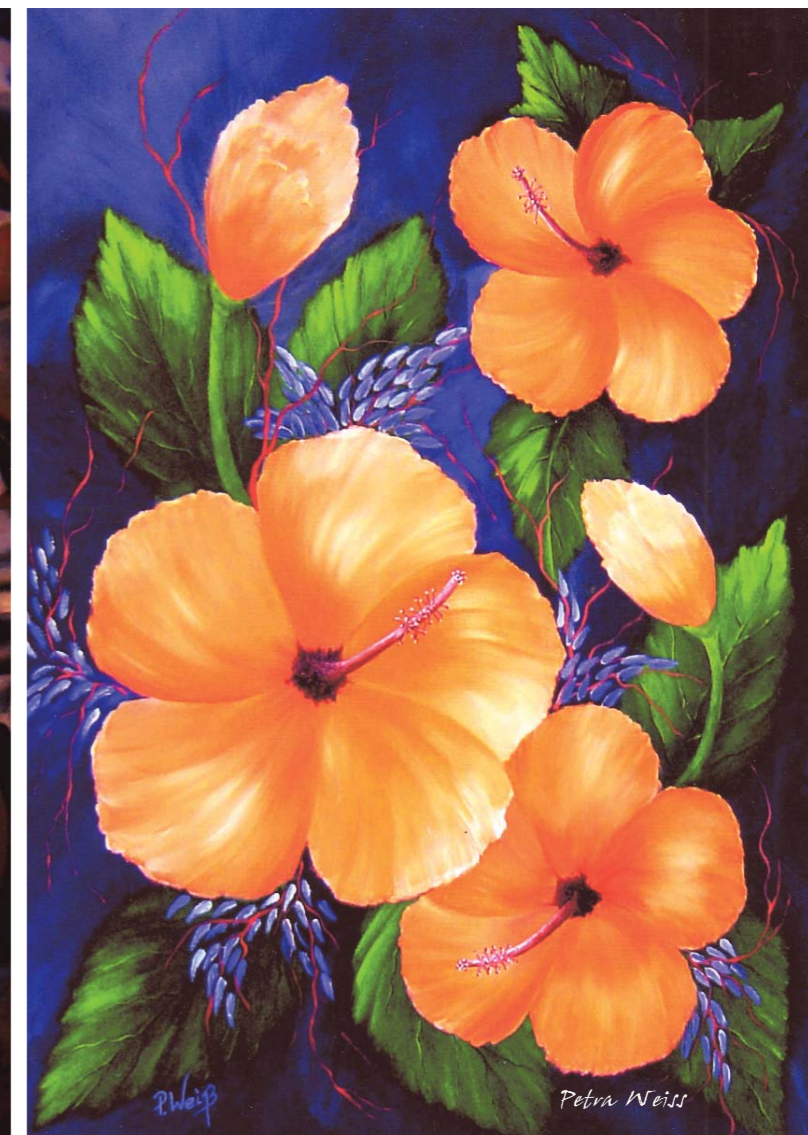
